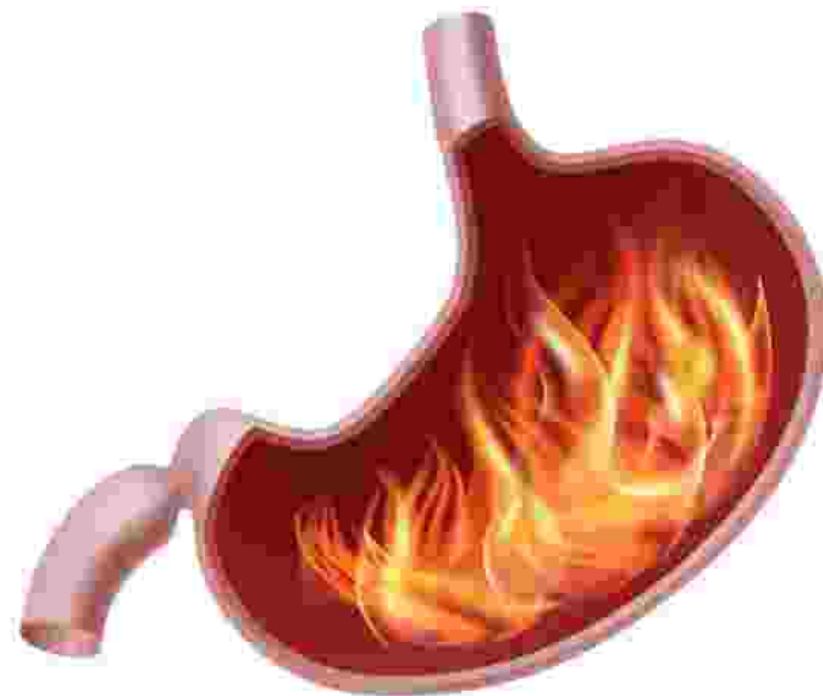

# ESOCAN-40

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Injection

Esomeprazole Sodium 40 mg

- Administered intravenously has similar safety & efficacy profiles to the oral formulation in patients with erosive esophagitis.

- Offers a faster onset of gastric suppression, achievement of intragastric pH closer to target levels, and better bioavailability.

- Provides better control of intragastric pH than omeprazole.
